

# East Asia in Wisconsin Library Program

2023-24 Application Information and Updated Book List

Fostering a better understanding of East Asia and its peoples is part of the core mission of the Center for East Asian Studies (CEAS) at the University of Wisconsin–Madison. To further this mission, CEAS, in partnership with the Cooperative Children's Book Center (CCBC) and the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) Public Library Development Team, created the East Asia in Wisconsin Library Program. The initiative supports collection development and programming at public libraries that will enrich understanding of East Asia in local communities across Wisconsin.

### **CEAS Grant Information**

**Grants of up to \$1,000 are available** to public libraries in Wisconsin, including school libraries, for:

- the purchase of East Asia-related materials to augment library collections;
- East Asian programming including, but not limited to: book club materials and programming, and hosting talks and lectures related to East Asia, etc.
- Staff time is not an allowable grant expense

Allowable grant fund expenditures:

- Materials
  - Books--any format
  - Films--anv format
  - Other materials for circulation
- Program expenses including
  - Multiple book copies (and formats) for book club kits
  - Honoraria for guest speakers/subject experts/performers
  - Marketing costs for advertising programs
  - Take-away craft kit materials (as long as no food items are included)

Any proposals that advance the broader mission of CEAS will be considered. This program is made possible by a U.S. Department of Education National Resource Center Title VI grant to support international education that furthers understanding of East Asia and East Asian languages.

### Additional details:

- For the purposes of this project, East Asia is defined as:
  - o China
  - Hong Kong
  - Japan
  - North Korea
  - South Korea
  - Taiwan
  - Tibet
  - Ethnic minorities that historically reside in these countries (Uighurs, Miao, Hakka Ainu, etc.)
- Proposals will be accepted through 5 PM Friday, September 29, 2023.
- We hope to notify applicants by 15 October 2023
- Funds will be awarded to successful applicants on a reimbursement basis. Libraries can submit invoices to CEAS for reimbursement. Purchases and expenses should be completed by 1 June, 2024, and checks for reimbursement should be expected within 4-6 weeks.

### **Evaluation criteria**

Application materials will be evaluated on these criteria:

- To ensure diversity in funding, CEAS will prioritize giving funding to libraries across all 16 Library Systems, with a wide range of populations served.
- Demonstrated need to diversify the library collection and/or program offerings.
- Libraries which received funding in previous cycles are eligible to apply.
